Adultery without deception, where the people involved agree to an open relationship is a matter of individual choice.

Our position on sexuality is to be smart, to be respectful of other people, to take into account the other person's feelings, hopes, and dreams, to be honest and open, to be trustworthy, to be responsible, and of course to be realistic. We realists are to be good sexual citizens and to strive for a world where sexuality is understood and appreciated.
