

Exposing Corruption

- Everyone has a right to expose corruption by individuals, businesses, government officials, or any other entity who is committing acts that are unfair or immoral.
- Everyone deserves the protection of the law for exposing corruption even if they have violated other laws for the purpose of exposing the corruption.
- No law shall be construed or applied in a manner that punishes those who expose corruption. Secrecy laws are intended to protect the public, not to conceal corruption and abuse.
